AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPE CORAL, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY OF CAPE CORAL, FLORIDA, CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 29, "ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND BUSINESS INCENTIVE PROGRAMS"; ARTICLE I, "GENERAL PROVISIONS", SECTIONS 29-2, 29-3, 29-4, REGARDING THE GOALS AND GENERAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES FOR THE ECONOMIC AND BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES; AMENDING CHAPTER 29, "ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND BUSINESS INCENTIVE PROGRAMS"; ARTICLE II, "INCENTIVES" 29-7, 29-8, 29-9 AND 29-10 REGARDING MODIFICATIONS TO CERTAIN ECONOMIC INCENTIVE PROGRAMS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION AND RESOLUTION OF CONFLICTING LAWS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 2. An estimate of the direct economic impact of the proposed ordinance on private, forprofit businesses in the City of Cape Coral, if any:
