FHWA - HURRICANE IAN BRIDGE REPAIRS Sands Blvd Over Eternity Canal



B) Repair of Bridge Structures 125717 (NB Span) and 125718 (SB Span) located over the Eternity Canal on Sands Boulevard:

1. Permanent Repair Design:

- a) Funded by FHWA (80%) and City of Cape Coral (20%).
- b) Local Funding Agreement Approved \$22,011.27
- c) Original Design no longer valid due to additional damages following subsequent storms.
- d) Revised DDIR approved: September 2025
- e) FDOT has committed to completing the design in-house to expedite completion.

2. Temporary Mitigation:

- a) Design Complete.
- b) Close of Formal Quote Solicitation: October 8, 2025.
- c) Construction Start: Mid-October

3. Closures & Monitoring:

a) Northbound bridge remains closed to vehicular traffic but open to boats. Staff and FDOT will reevaluate the possibility of opening the bridge to vehicular traffic following the completion of Temporary Mitigation.

4. Permitting:

 a) Hydrologic and Hydraulic Analysis underway per FEMA and SFWMD permit requirements.




Stormwater Operational Projects

1. Hancock Bridge Parkway Drainage Improvements – Design complete

a) A study was conducted to determine the cause of flooding on a neighborhood scale surrounding Hancock Bridge Pkwy. Multiple design alternatives were provided to the City for cost-benefit evaluation. The selected method was designed and submitted for

construction.

- b) 100% Design received on January 23, 2024
- c) Bid opening that occurred on July 15, 2024 was contested. All bids were rejected
- d) Second bid opening occurred on April 16, 2025 with contract awarded to V&H Construction
- e) Limited NTP issued 9/23/25.
- f) A change order addressing funding for utility relocations is currently on the 10/8/25 Council agenda.





Water Quality Projects

1. Palmetto Pines Golf Course Irrigation


- a) Irrigation water is currently pumped and discharged into the Makai Canal. A new intake point in the Ticonderoga Canal has been designed to create circulation and improve water quality in both canals. Construction and maintenance agreements with private property owners required to proceed with development.
- b) Design plans are complete. The City's Site Development Permit is complete. Agreements with private property owners for construction of the pump intake and the pump station are drafted and ready for signature once new bid numbers are obtained.
- c) Funding for this project has not been identified.

Waterways Stakeholders Group


1) Update:

- a) The Public Works Department established a new Waterways Stakeholders Group on 10/1/25, nominating 12 members.
- b) Quarterly meetings scheduled for the first year, so far include two informational sessions on 10/20/25 and 11/3/25 on water quality, navigation, long-range planning and prioritization processes for dredging, aquatic vegetation harvesting, and public boat ramps' development and maintenance.
- 2) Information provided in previous quarterly updates:
 - a) A final meeting with the previous stakeholders' group was held on 07/14/25. Two stakeholders out of 10 attended. New Organization and selection process presented.
 - b) City advertised applications 7/15/25 9/15/25 to fill positions.



City Hall and Council Building Security Upgrades

- 1. Design submittal for City Hall rear parking lot fence and pop-up gates re-submitted for permitting 9/26/25.
- 2. Decorative fence/gates around the Council Building parking lot were installed in late February. Automation of the gates completed in August along with PW/ITS training session with the council for gate operation. Project completed.




