

Irrigation Filter Ownership/Maintenance Agreement

As requested, the City of Cape Coral will supply you with an irrigation Filter for

- ☐ **(Self-Install)** Customer will install the City supplied irrigation filter to prevent debris from getting into the customers sprinkler system. Customer assumes responsibility for all maintenance, cleaning, flushing of filter and any future repairs. Includes a 1-year factory warranty (no Labor) with replacement by customer.
- ☐ **(City Install)** A utilities representative will determine a safe location to install the irrigation filter between the City's Irrigation box and your sprinkler control valves. Please note** If you have landscape materials and/or plantings that will conflict with the proposed location, the utilities staff will notify you to remove these at your cost, or placement of the filter in an alternative location. * Includes a 1-year warranty with replacement by City Staff for units installed/replaced after 1/1/2014

Flushing Maintenance:

The City provides this filter for free for customers that are affected by debris in the lines. The customer is responsible for all future repairs and maintenance of the unit including routine cleaning and flushing. Flush filter weekly to clear any blockage by opening the $\frac{3}{4}$ " flushing handle at the bottom of the filter (slowly) to allow the debris to exit the filter. To clean cartridge, close the main shut off valve (red handle) $\frac{1}{4}$ turn clockwise. Relieve the internal pressure of the filter by opening the flushing handle, lower housing assembly, remove cartridge and clean with bleach and water. Once clean, reassemble the unit by reversing the cleaning procedure and lightly tighten the lower housing assembly to prevent leaks form overtightening.

Note* Do not connect a hose to the $\frac{3}{4}$ " flushing handle at the bottom of the filter, as it can damage the filter assembly.
