

In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the April 5, 2023, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

## **Council Approves Utilities Landscaping Contract**

Resolution 59-23 awarded the contract for grounds maintenance of select utility work sites, canal pump stations, wells, and wastewater lift stations to Clean Cut Lawn Services of Lee County, Inc., Cape Coral, FL.

## **Council Approves Change Order for Debris Monitoring Firm**

Resolution 82-23 approves Change Order No. 1 and all future change orders for the City's contract with Tetra Tech, Inc., for emergency debris removal monitoring services due to Hurricane Ian.

## **Council Approves Chamber of Commerce Lease Agreement**

Resolution 85-23 approves the transfer of the lease agreement between the City of Cape Coral and the Cape Coral Chamber of Commerce Foundation, Inc., for the property at 2051 Cape Coral Parkway East.

#### **Hurricane Ian Update – Trash Tote Delivery**

The City of Cape Coral received its first shipment of replacement trash totes Monday. Delivery to residents began yesterday and should take up to three weeks to complete.

# **Public Hearing for Moratorium on Self-Storage Facilities**

The first public hearing was held for Resolution 32-30, an ordinance enacting a moratorium on accepting applications and issuing permits for developing self-storage facilities within all zoning districts in the City of Cape Coral. The final public hearing is scheduled for April 19, 2023.
