Community Recognition: Blue Line Bears

City Council and the City Manager recognize the exemplary achievements of Cape Coral residents. Blue Line Bears is a local non-profit that makes teddy bears from the uniforms of first responders killed in the line of duty. This gesture has helped hundreds of children overcome the loss of a parent.

Council Approves Acceptance of Drug Recognition Expert Call-Out Funds
Council approved Resolution 326-23, accepting \$10,000 from the Institute of Police
Technology and Management to fund overtime for Drug Recognition Experts, who are
called to conduct investigations for driving under the influence.

Council Approves Acceptance of Grant Funds for Crisis Negotiation Team City Council approved Resolution 327-23, accepting \$3,500 in grant funding from the Walmart Local Giving Team to purchase equipment for the Crisis Negotiation Team.

Council Approves Construction Bid for North 1 West UEP Master Pump Station City Council approved Resolution 332-23, approving the bid award and corresponding contract with PWC Joint Venture, LLC for the construction of Master Pump Station 720 for the North 1 West Utilities Extension Project.

Council Approves Consulting Services for Northeast Reservoir Storage Enhancement Project

City Council approved Resolution 333-23, approving an agreement with Kisinger Campo & Associates, Corp., to provide professional engineering and hydrologic consulting services for the Northeast Reservoir Storage Enhancement Project.
