



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the October 2, 2024, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Approves Contract for Mobility Plan and Fee System

Council approved Resolution 319-24, awarding the contract for creation of the City's Mobility Plan and Fee System to NUE Urban Concepts. The proposed plan and fee align with the City's Comprehensive Plan Transportation Element Goals to provide residents with an efficient, balanced, and safe motorized and non-motorized transportation system.

Council Approves Grant Agreement for EOC Expansion

Council approved Resolution 325-24, accepting an additional \$9,000,000 in funding from the Florida Division of Emergency Management. The grant will help fund an expansion of Cape Coral's Emergency Operations Center, a centralized facility where government officials and emergency responders coordinate and manage response efforts during a crisis or disaster to ensure public safety and effective resource deployment.

Public Hearing Set for Victory Park Community Development District Expansion

The City of Cape Coral received a request to expand the boundaries of the Victory Park Community Development District. If approved, this would expand the project to the east and increase the total acreage from 137.39 acres to 259.36 acres. The public hearing is scheduled for Wednesday, October 16.
