

In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the September 4, 2024, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Approves Hiring of Contractor for Chiquita Lock Removal

Council approved Resolution 287-24, allowing the City of Cape Coral to hire a contractor to remove the Chiquita Lock once the Army Corps of Engineers issues the required permits. This project is part of a broader initiative to improve water quality in the area.

Council Approves Contract for School Zone Speed Detection Systems

Council approved Resolution 214-24, awarding a contract for school zone speed detection systems to RedSpeed Florida, LLC. On June 5, 2024, Council approved Resolution 39-24, establishing a school zone speed enforcement program in accordance with House Bill 657. Speed detection systems will be installed in 17 school zones in Cape Coral after a study revealed over 100 drivers speeding throughout the marked school zones. Drivers who travel 10 MPH above the posted school zone speed limit during set hours will be subject to a \$100 fine.
