



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the September 18, 2024, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Community Recognition: Olympian Fernando Jorge Enriquez

City Council and the City Manager recognize the exemplary achievements of Cape Coral residents. Cape Coral resident, Fernando Jorge Enriquez, competed on the International Olympic Committee Refugee Olympic Canoeing Team for the Paris 2024 Olympics. Enriquez also previously competed for Cuba in the Tokyo 2020 and Rio 2016 Olympics.

Council Approves Extension of Founder's Rate for Lake Kennedy Racquet Center

Council approved Resolution 309-24, extending the Founder's Rate option for annual memberships at Lake Kennedy Racquet Center from September 30 to October 28, 2024. Founding members will receive a 50 percent discount on the annual membership rate for the first year.

Council Approves Recommended Improvements to Evacuation Route Study

Council approved Resolution 318-24, supporting recommended improvements to the Cape Coral Evacuation Route Study. This resolution also urges the Lee County Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Florida Department of Transportation to immediately prioritize an additional evacuation route for the City of Cape Coral, which would ensure the health, safety, and welfare of residents during a hurricane evacuation.
