

In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the November 19, 2025, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Awards Bid for Veterans Court Tennis Courts Project

Council approved Resolution 287-25, awarding a bid to Sport Surfaces, LLC, to add tennis courts to Veterans Park, 4140 Coronado Parkway, along with other park improvements. In addition to the new tennis courts, Sport Surfaces will resurface the existing basketball court, concrete sidewalk, and on-site landscape feature.

Council Accepts Grant Funding for Adaptive Tennis Initiative

Council accepted grant funds from the United States Tennis Association to support the launch of an adaptive tennis initiative for individuals with mobility impairments. Resolution 326-25 provides \$6,100 for the introduction of a tournament-grade tennis wheelchair at The Courts, Cape Coral, enabling inclusive recreational play, instructional clinics, and community outreach events.

Council Approves Collection of Initiatives for North 1 East Utilities Extension Project (UEP)

Council approved:

- Resolutions 351-25, 352-25, & 353-25, formally establishing project areas for the North 1 East UEP and how much each property will pay toward the cost of irrigation water, wastewater, and potable water improvements, respectively.
- Resolutions 347-25, 349-25, and 350-25, authorizing an interlocal agreement between the Lee County Tax Collector and the City of Cape Coral for the collection of non-ad valorem assessments related to the North 1 East irrigation, wastewater, and potable water UEP improvements, respectively.
- Resolutions 331-25, 332-25, and 333-25 awarding construction contracts for North 1 East UEP to:
 - Guymann Construction of Florida, Denco Construction Inc., and Southwest Utility Systems Inc. for the construction of potable water, wastewater, and irrigation water mains, storm drain replacement, wastewater pump stations, restoration, road reconstruction, and other related work.
 - Southwest Utility Systems, Inc. for the construction of Master Pump Station No. 725.
 - Tetra Tech, Inc. for construction engineering and inspection services

Council Awards Contract for Community Recreation Center, Disaster Shelter Study

Council approved Resolution 339-25, awarding a Request for Proposal to Ohlson Lavoie Corporation for the completion of a Community Recreation Center and Disaster Shelter Study. The City was awarded grant funding to conduct a study for the center, which will provide year-round multi-use services while ensuring the capacity to serve as a critical resilience resource during emergencies.
