

# **Electric Miscellaneous - Residential Permit Guidelines**

## Electrical Contractor or Owner/Builder may apply for permit

- Trade application.
- Owner Builder Affidavit (if homeowner).
- NOC required if value is \$2500 or greater.

## **Description:**

• Description of work being done (i.e. wiring of boat lift, replace meter can, etc)

#### Route to: OFFICE USE ONLY

CSR to approve over the counter.

Notice of Commencement (NOC)Electric Final (040)20

Hook-up/SRV CHG (023)

#### Fees:

Electric Misc w/o Plans \$60.00

Surcharge for Docks & Boat Lifts

#### **Expiration:**

• Six (6) months

#### **NOTES:**

Any work that requires LCEC to come out and disconnect/reconnect the power should receive both the Electric Hook-up/SRVCHG (023) and the Electric Final (040). Examples include panel replacement, riser replacement, meter can replacements and houses labeled as grow houses.
