

## A/C Change-Out Permit Guidelines - Residential

**Description:** Use this permit type for residential (1 or 2 family homes) A/C change out and duct repair/replacement. For **new Mini-Split systems** a separate Electrical Misc. permit is required to be pulled by an Electrician.

**License Requirements:** A CAC, CMC, or owner/builder may apply for this permit.

#### **Documents required at Application:**

#### For Owner/Builder in person:

\*\*2 copies required for each of the below\*\*

- Paper trade application
- HVAC Data Sheet
- **Duct Plan** (only if performing duct work)
  - Duct Certification required to be posted on-site only
- Owner/Builder Affidavit
  - Must be Notarized
- NOC if valuation is \$15000 or greater:
  - o May be submitted after application, but before the 1<sup>st</sup> inspection
  - Must be Notarized
  - Must be recorded and certified by Lee County. If only recorded, then a NOC Affidavit is also required

#### For Registered Contractors online:

\*\*Push Button Permit\*\*

- Apply on CSS: select "A/C Change Out Residential"
- **Duct Plan** (only if performing duct work)
  - Duct Certification required to be posted on-site only
- NOC if Valuation is \$15000 or greater:
  - o May be submitted after application, but before the 1<sup>st</sup> inspection
  - Must be Notarized
  - Must be recorded and certified by Lee County. If only recorded, then a NOC Affidavit is also required


