Cape Coral Budget Items in SB 2500 - General Appropriations Act

- \$ 2 million - Historic Caloosahatchee Shoreline Preservation Project - Line 1682 C
- \$ 5 million - Northeast Reservoir Transmission Main and Pump Station - Line 1705 A
- \$ 1 million - Emergency Operations Center/Fire Station No. 10 - Line 2485A
- \$ 9 million - Emergency Operations Center Expansion - Line 2710

Total \$17 million
